Directions

From Route 93: Take **Exit 4** and travel **East on Route 102** thru Derry, NH for **2** miles to **Rotary** (Rt. 28 Bypass). Continue on Route 102 for **4.6** miles. Barn is on the left after top of the hill.
From Route 101: Take **Exit 5** onto **Route 102 West** (Route 107 also). Stay on Rt. 102 West to the **blinking light** at the center of Chester (Jct. 121). Go straight thru; barn is .7 miles on the right side of the street.

Rules and Regulations

1. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage, Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) Leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
2. Judges decisions are final.
3. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change order or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
4. Courses will consist of post and rails, walls, gates, pickets and brush.
5. Championship and reserve ribbons will be awarded in all divisions. Champion and reserve will be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points in the over fence classes in their division. In addition to these points, only those horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in the under saddle classes. Points to be awarded through the first six places: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2.
6. A trophy and 8 ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
7. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current NEHC Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance there within.
8. **Warm-ups are \$20.00. You must have a ticket to go into warm-up.**
9. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.
10. Returned checks are subject to a \$25.00 fee.
11. **Please - Keep dogs on a leash !**
12. Post entries will be accepted, but there will be a one time post entry fee of \$10.00/horse for those not entered until the day of the show. No penalty fee will be charged for entering additional classes on the day of the show.
13. **All regular classes are \$20.00.
Medal Classes are \$30.00.
All 3'6" Medal Classes are \$40.00.**

15. Ring Dimensions: Ring 1 - 100' X 250' Ring 2 - 95' X 200'

16. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

17. Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

17. **Open Equitation** – Flat under 18. Walk, Trot, Canter. Tests 1-19. NEHC “C” rated.
18. **Open Equitation** – Fences under 18. Fences not to exceed 3’. Tests 1-19. NEHC “C” rated.
37. **Granite State 18" Novice Medal** – fences not to exceed 18’. Junior and adult riders not having shown over 18" must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18.
40. **Downeast Junior Mini-Medal** - Open to riders 17 years and younger. Riders may compete on horses or ponies. Riders must not compete during the year in equitation classes over fences that exceed 18". Contestants shall be required to perform a minimum of eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence height will be 18". 25% of exhibitors, at least 2, will be called back for individual testing. USEF tests 1-8.
51. **Granite State Children’s Medal** – fences not to exceed 2’3". Junior riders who have not shown over 2’6" at a recognized show must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18.
52. **Downeast Children's Medal** - Open to riders 17 years of age and younger, competing on ponies or horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights not to exceed 2'3". 25% of the contestants, at least 2, shall be called back for individual testing. USEF tests 1-8.
15. **Granite State Pony Medal** – fences not to exceed 2’3" for small and medium ponies and 2’6" for large ponies. Junior pony riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18.

Suitable Hunter Division

Unrated. Open to beginning horses or riders of any age. Horse/rider combinations may not have competed over 18" at any previous show. Shown over 4 to 8 fences not to exceed 18" with no combinations. May not cross enter into any division requiring horses to jump over 18" at the same show. May trot or canter fences.

Miscellaneous Classes

42. **NEHC English Pleasure Horse/Pony Class** – open to members and nonmembers of the NEHC. Open to all horses and ponies ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of rider or place of residence. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Will be required to back. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order.
25. **Open Leadline.** *Unrated.* Open to riders 8 years of age and under. To be shown collectively at the walk and individually at the trot.
26. **Leadline Suitability.** Same specifications as class #25.
27. **Walk-Trot Hunt Seat Equitation.** NEHC “C”. Open to riders 10 years of age and under. No child entered may compete in any other class requiring entries to canter. Rider must not have been judged in a class at a show that requires a canter. To be judged at a walk and trot both ways of the ring.
28. **Walk-Trot Beginners Pleasure.** NEHC “C”. Same specifications as class #27.
29. **Walk-Trot Hunter Under Saddle.** *Unrated.* To be judged as a hunter class. Same specifications as class #27.
30. **Downeast Walk-Trot Poles Medal** - Open to riders 14 years and younger. Must not have competed in a class where a canter is required. Contestants shall be required to show at a trot over a minimum of 4 rails (poles) on the ground. 25% of exhibitors, at least 2, shall be called back for individual testing. Verbal testing encouraged
1. **Low Hunter.** *Unrated.* Fences 2’3"-2’6" or 2’9"-3' before respective classes of that height. No restrictions for horses or riders. Ponies may enter. Intended as a warm-up class. Open all day ONLY before a hunter round. Trophy and 8 ribbons.

To be shown by junior exhibitors. Junior exhibitors 15-17 years of age must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 2' for small/medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies, 3' for horses. If entries warrant, the division may be split at the discretion of the show management. Same horse/rider combination cannot show in any other rated division except equitation at that show. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division or section at the same show. Ponies may not cross enter into regular pony hunter division.

19. **Granite State Junior Medal** – fences not to exceed 3'. Junior riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18.
20. **Downeast Junior Medal** - Open to riders 17 years of age and younger, competing on horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights not to exceed 2'9". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. USEF tests 1-19.
22. **NEHC Junior Hunt Seat Medal Class** – open to Jr. members of NEHC who have not reached their 18th birthday. All Contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. USEF Tests 1-19. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. One win required for the finals.
21. **T.H.I.S. National Children's Medal** – open to Jr. members of the USEF or CEF who have never competed in a National Equitation Finals with fences at 3'6". All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9"-3', spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least 2 changes of direction and a combination. The top 4 riders or 20% of the first round competitors, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least 2 individual tests from USEF Tests 1-19. An open numerical scoring system will be used in the first round.
23. **Pessoa's USEF Hunter Seat Medal Class** – open to Junior members of the USEF who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Application for membership may be made through the show steward. Fence heights 3'6".

24. **ASPCA Horsemanship Class** – for Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. No participant will be allowed in a class unless they are a Junior patron and must show their ASPCA number on the entry blank. Annual contributions shall be \$15.00. Application for membership must be made directly to the Horsemanship Department, ASPCA, 441 East 92nd Street, New York, NY 10028. Fence heights 3’6".
46. **Granite Sate Modified Amateur Adult Medal** –fence heights not to exceed 2’3". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven’t shown over 2’6" at a recognized show must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18.
47. **Downeast Modified Adult Medal** - Open ro riders 18 years of age or older, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall berequired to perform over a minimum of eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights not to exceed 2’3". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. USEF tests 1-18
8. **Granite State Adult Medal** – fences not to exceed 2’9". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18.
9. **Downeast Amateur Adult Medal** - Open to riders 18 years of age or older, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights not to exceed 2’9". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. USEF tests 1-19.

10. **Ariat Adult Medal** – open to all members of the USEF or CEF who are eligible to compete in the Amateur Adult Hunter section at this show. All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2’9"-3’, spreads not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a jumper or hunter type course and must include at least 2 changes of direction and a combination. The top 4 riders or 20% of the first round competitors, which ever is greater, are required to perform at least 2 individual tests from USEF Tests 1-19. An open numerical scoring system will be used in the first round.
11. **NEHC Adult/Amateur Hunt Seat Medal** – open to amateur adult members of the NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3’. One or more individual tests of the top 4 riders may be requested at the judge’s discretion. To fill a class at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

SHORT STIRRUP DIVISION

Open to all riders 12 years of age and under. Riders may not compete in any other equitation class at any show and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18". Fences may be taken at a trot or canter at the option of the rider.
