Open to Junior and Adult riders. Fences not to exceed 3'. The first round will be a handy hunter course and will be scored using the open numerical scoring system. Each contestant's score will be announced at the end of their round. The course may include: a roll-back, unrelated distances, trotting and/or hand-galloping a jump, and possible option jumps. The top 12 scoring riders will be called back for an under-saddle phase. The Judge will determine the placings according to performance in both phases.

To be eligible the horse and/or rider must have participated in our May 7th or June 4th show in their respective division.

In the first round all contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. At least one test from USEF tests 1-18 will be included in the course. The first round will be scored using the open numerical scoring system. Each contestant's score will be announced. The top 12 contestants will be called back for a flat phase. The Judge will determine the placings according to performance in both phases. First and second place winners will receive a Dover Saddlery Gift Certificate and all places will receive an embroidered saddle pad. Ribbons will be awarded to 8th place.

To be eligible the horse and/or rider must have participated in our May 7th or June 4th show in their respective division.

(Entry fee \$40)

Rules and Regulations

- 1 Judges decisions are final.
- 2 The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change order or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
3. Courses will consist of post and rails, walls, gates, pickets and brush.
- 4 Championship and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in all divisions. Champion and Reserve will be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points in the over fence classes in their division. In addition to these points, only those horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in the under saddle classes. Points to be awarded through the first six places: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2.
5. A trophy and 6 ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
6. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current NEHC Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance there within.
7. **Warm-ups are \$20.00. You must have a number to go into warm-up.**
8. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.
9. Returned checks are subject to a \$25.00 fee.
10. **Please - Keep dogs on a leash !**
- 11 Post entries will be accepted, but there will be a one time post entry fee of \$10.00/horse for those not entered until the day of the show. No penalty fee will be charged for entering additional classes on the day of the show.
12. **All regular classes are \$20.00.
All Medal Classes are \$30.00.**
13. Footing: Warm-up and Competition Rings are all weather footing.
14. Ring Dimensions: Ring 1 - 100' x 200' Ring 2 - 95' x 200'
15. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

High Point Trainer's Award

Award to be presented to the trainer with the most points for students or horses they ride. Trainers must sign up at the start of each horse show to qualify and must identify their students and horses.

Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the Judge. USEF Test 1-18. Note: when rider win medal class at year-end finals two years consecutively, the rider must move up to the NH Junior Medal or the NH Adult Medal.

One win required to qualify for the finals.

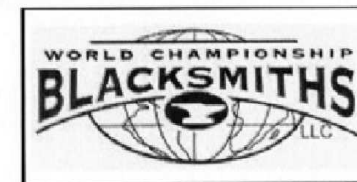

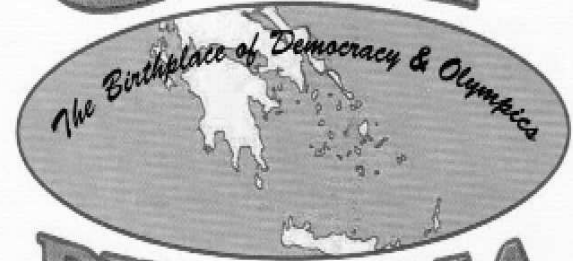

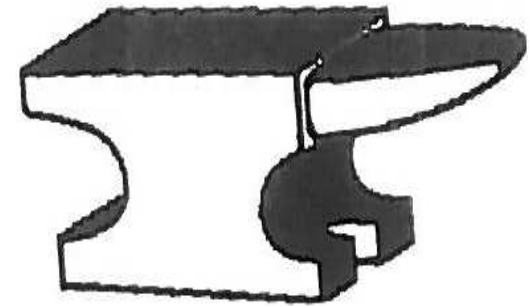
