RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. 6 ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise noted. Championship and reserve ribbons in each division will be awarded in accordance with USEF rules.
- 2. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules & Specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Classes not covered by USEF rules to be run under the rules of the NEHC. USEF rules take precedence.
- 3. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise stated.
- 4. Entry Fees: \$25.00 Regular Classes and \$35.00 for Medal Classes unless otherwise noted.
- 5. Ring s 100×200 with a well-groomed sand based footing. Warm Up Areas with a stone dust and sand footing.
- 6. Entries close the Thursday before the show at 8PM. Post entries will be charged a fee of \$20.00 for the day. NO telephone entries will be accepted.
- 7. Competition management shall place a minimum of one sharps container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up too \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
- 8. ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED.
- 9. Judges decisions are final.
- 10. Any division with over 40 entries will be divided, with prize monies doubled. The Show Management reserves the right to further cancel, combine, or divide classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
- 11. Membership applications are available from the Show Secretary the day of the show.
- 12. To be eligible for stake classes, entrants must have shown in one other class in the same division. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of entry fee and any prize awarded.
- 13. Courses consist of post and rails, walls, gates, pickets and brush fences.
- 14. Current negative Coggins Test is required.
- 15. All returned checks will be charged a \$50.00 fee, and entrants will not be allowed to compete unless all previous indebtedness has been cleared. Any person or farm with more than two returned checks within a calendar year will be required to pay all fees by money order or cash for the balance of the year.
- 16. Refunds of entry fees will not be made unless a veterinarian or doctor's certificate of lameness, injury, or illness is shown. Refunds will be made if a class is canceled.
- 17. Parking is allowed only in designated areas.
- 18. Helmets must meet or exceed ASTM/SEI safety standards and be worn at all times while mounted. Chin straps must be securely fastened.
- 19. Lungeing and schooling will only be permitted in designated areas.
- 20. All entries for NEHC medal classes must have their membership number or a copy of their temporary membership card with them. Entries without membership numbers will not be accepted. If you know you are a member and cannot remember your number, you can fill out a Membership Affidavit. There is a \$25.00 fee which will be returned to you when your membership is validated. If you join NEHC at the horse show, please make sure you get your Temporary Membership from the show office.
- 21. All entries are required to pay \$2 fee to NEHC. EXCLUDING JUNE 3RD SHOW.

BEGINNER CLASSES

Entry Fees: \$25

LEADLINE HUNTER, SUITABILITY & EQUITATION Open to riders 7 years or under. Rider must be led at all times by someone 14 years of age or older. May be asked to trot or back individually.

WALK TROT HUNTER, SUITABILITY, & EQUITATION Open to riders 10 years of age or under. Shall show at the walk and trot ONLY. No child entered may compete in any other class requiring to canter. Rider must not have ever been judged in a class at a show that required a canter.

WALK TROT HUNTER & EQ POLES Open to riders 10 years of age or under. Shall show at the walk and trot ONLY. No child entered may compete in any other class requiring rider to canter. Riders must not have ever been judged in a class at a show that required a canter.

BEGINNER EQUITATION & PLEASURE Open to all riders that have never been judged in a class requiring rider to jump over 18". Shall show at the walk trot and canter. Riders may not enter into any other divisions. No more than 3 to canter at a time.

BEGINNER CROSSRAILS Open to all riders that have never been judged in a class requiring rider to jump over 18". Riders shall be required to perform over a minimum of 4 fences. Fences shall all be crossrails at a height of 12"-18".

EQUITATION

Entry Fees: \$25

NOVICE EQUITATION FENCES Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have never jumped over 2' at a recognized show. Fences 18"

NOVICE EQUITATION FLAT Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have never jumped over 2' at a recognized show.

PRE CHILD/ADULT EQUITATION Open to junior or amateur adult riders that have never shown over 2'3" at a recognized show. Open to horses or ponies. Fences 2'

PRE CHILD/ADULT EQUITATION FLAT Open to junior or amateur adult riders that have never show over 2'3" at a recognized show. Open to horses or ponies.

MODIFIED EQUITATION FENCES Open to junior or amateur adult riders that have never shown over 2'6 at a recognized show. Open to horses or ponies. Fences 2'3

MODIFIED EQUITATION FLAT Open to junior or amateur adult riders that have never shown over 2'6 at a recognized show. Open to horses or ponies.

SPECIAL CHILD/ADULT EQUITATION FENCES Riders must not have jumped over 3' in a class at a recognized show. Fences 2'6

SPECIAL CHILD/ADULT EQUITATION FLAT Riders must not have jumped over 3' in a class at a recognized show.

INTERMEDIATE EQUITATION FENCES Open to junior riders and amateur adult riders who have never jumped over 3' in a class at a recognized show. Fences 2'9"

INTERMEDIATE EQUITATION FLAT Open to junior riders and amateur adult riders who have never jumped over 3' in a class at a recognized show.

JUNIOR/AMATEUR EQUITATION FENCES Open to junior and amateur adult riders. Fences 3'

JUNIOR/AMATEUR EQUITATION FLAT Open to junior and amateur adult riders.

MEDAL CLASSES

Entry Fees: \$35

DOWNEAST JUNIOR MEDAL Open to riders 17 years of age and under competing on horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'9". Testing optional. USEF tests 1-19.

DOWNEAST AMATEUR ADULT MEDAL - Open to amateur riders 18 years of age or older, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'6". Testing optional. USEF tests 1-19.

DOWNEAST MODIFIED JUNIOR MEDAL Open to riders 17 years of age and younger, competing on ponies or horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'3". Testing optional. USEF tests 1-8.

DOWNEAST MODIFIED ADULT MEDAL Open to amateur riders 18 years of age or older, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'3". Testing optional. USEF tests 1-8.

DOWNEAST WALK-TROT POLES MEDAL Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Must not have shown over fences or cantered at any horse show. Contestants shall be required to show at a trot over a minimum of four rails (poles) on the ground. If a rider wins the medal final, they are no longer eligible to compete in this division. 25% of contestants, at least two, may be called back for testing. Testing optional, verbal testing recommended.

DOWNEAST SHORT & LONG STIRRUP MEDAL Open to riders 13 years of age and older through amateur adults. All riders must be in their first three years of showing over fences and must never have competed in a class or division with fences higher than 18". Adults may apply for review under rule #27 if they have shown higher than 18" in the past 3 years and show extenuating circumstances. If a rider wins the medal final, they are no longer eligible to compete in this division. Riders shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence height will be 18". 25% of contestants, at least 2, may be called back for individual testing. Testing optional, verbal recommended. USEF tests 1-8. All adult equitation riders must have proof of amateur status from MHA, NHHJA, NEHC, USEF or any recognized breed organization. Both Short and Long Stirrup may compete together at the qualifying shows, however they will be separated at the Finals into Short Stirrup 12 & under, and Long Stirrup 13 and over through adults.

DOWNEAST MINI MEDAL Open to riders 17 years of age and younger. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2' for small & medium ponies, 2'6" for large ponies and horses. Testing optional. USEF tests 1-8. NOTE: small and medium ponies will be able to complete the class at 2' following the 2' division. The card will remain open until large ponies and horses complete the class following the 2'6 division.

MEDAL CLASSES Cont.

NH ADULT MEDAL fences not to exceed 2'9". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older must accumulate 10 points in order to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. NH Adult Medal and NH Junior Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height. Note: When rider wins Adult medal class at year-end finals, he/she must skip one (1) year of competing in the class at the finals, but may return to compete in the class the following year.

NH JUNIOR MEDAL fences not to exceed 3'. Junior riders must accumulate 10 points in order to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. NH Junior Medal and NH Adult Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height. Note: When rider wins Junior medal class at year-end finals, the rider no longer eligible to compete in the class again at finals.

NH CHILDREN'S MEDAL fence heights not to exceed 2'6" for large ponies/horses, 2' for small/medium ponies. Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 3' at any recognized show. Children's riders must accumulate 10 points in order to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-8. NH Children's Medal, NH Modified Children's Medal and/or NH Modified Adult Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height. Note: If a rider wins Children's medal class at year-end finals two (2) years consecutively, the rider is no longer eligible to compete in class again at finals.

NH MODIFIED CHILDREN'S MEDAL fence heights not to exceed 2'3". Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-7. NH Modified Children's Medal, NH Modified Adult Medal and/or NH Children's Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height. Note: When rider wins Modified Children's medal class at year-end finals two (2) years consecutively, the rider is no longer eligible to compete in class again at finals.

NH MODIFIED AMATEUR ADULT MEDAL fence heights 2'3"-2'6". Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show in the current show season. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-7. NH Modified Adult Medal, NH Modified Children's Medal and/or NH Children's Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height. Note: When rider wins Modified Adult medal class at yearend finals, he/she must skip one (1) year of competing in the class at the finals but may return to compete in the class the following year.

NH NOVICE MEDAL fence heights not to exceed 18". Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have never shown higher than 2' at a recognized show. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. Note: When rider wins Novice medal class at year-end finals 2 years consecutively, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class again at finals.

MEDAL CLASSES Cont.

NEHC ADULT MEDAL Open to adult amateur members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set at a height from 2'9" to 3' with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. **NOTE: Not offered for the 6/3 date.**

NEHC JUNIOR MEDAL Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set to a height from 3' to 3'3" with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. NOTE: Not offered for the 6/3 date.

HUNTER CLASSES

Entry Fees: \$25

HORSE AND PONY HUNTER PLEASURE Open to all riders regardless of status. To be judged on manners and way of going. Riders may be asked to halt, back, and/or extended trot.

PREP HUNTER Open to all riders fences to be set at height of current classes.

NOVICE HUNTER Open to junior and amateur riders who are eligible for short or long stirrup equitation over fences as of December of the current show year. Horses or Ponies. Fence height 18' with no combinations. At the same show, the same horse/rider or pony/rider may not cross enter into beginner equitation or hunter or any class where fences exceed 18".

UNJUDGED 18" MULLIGAN HUNTER Open to competitors in the Novice Hunter or Equitation classes that are in need of an extra schooling round. To be run at the completion of scheduled classes in Ring 2. Rider will be allowed to choose one of the posted Novice courses to complete. Trainers must remain outside of the show ring and riders will be allowed 3 refusals before being dismissed. Additional courses may be allowed at the discretion of the ring steward but will be charged an additional class fee. No ribbons or prizes will be awarded for this class. CLASS WILL CLOSE 30 MINUTES AFTER the COMPLETION OF RING 2.

PUDDLE HUNTER Open to all riders. Fence height 2'


SCHOOLING HUNTER Open to all riders. Fence height 2' 3"

OPEN SPECIAL HUNTER Open to all riders. Fence height 2'6

INTERMEDIATE HUNTER Open to all riders. Fence height 2'9"

OPEN HUNTER Open to all riders. Fence height 3'

UNJUDGED 2'6" MULLIGAN HUNTER Open to riders that have shown in at least 1 over fences class in Ring 1 and are in need of an extra schooling round. To be run at the completion of scheduled classes in Ring 1. Rider will be allowed to choose one of the posted courses to complete. Trainers must remain outside of the show ring and riders will be allowed 3 refusals before being dismissed. Additional courses may be allowed at the discretion of the ring steward but will be charged an additional class fee. No ribbons or prizes will be awarded for this class. CLASS WILL CLOSE 30 MINUTES AFTER THE COMPLETION OF RING 1.

Every entry at a recognized show shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, along with the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, and the horse (1) shall be subject to the Constitution and rules of the Association and the local rules of the show; (2) that every horse, rider, and/or driver is eligible as entered;(3) that the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the Constitution and Rules of the NEHC and the show will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, the NEHC, their officials, directors and employees hards for any action taken; (4) that the owner, rider/driver and any of their agents or representatives agree to hold the NEHC, the show, and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the NEHC or show.


